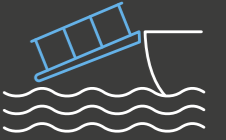

360° SERVICE

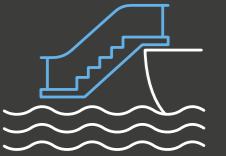

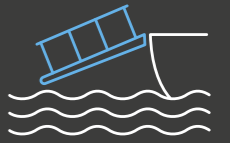

Gangways

Gangway represents the best calling card for any luxury yacht. For this reason, the company is specialized in the creation of a wide range of products to make unique and stable the access to the yacht. The walking surface can be defined by more telescopic elements and different stanchions options. A new product with dual usability, which operates both as a gangway and a ladder, has been designed to create a perfect solution for yachts with limited space on board. This product is designed to store the gangway and when it is extended, the ladder will become an integral part of it. Over the years Sanguineti has developed different

models to satisfy the market multiple needs, from light alloy gangways to those in 316L stainless steel. A special attention has always been dedicated to the handling typology: the five models available are different in execution with inclination pin flush with the hull, outside the hull or with lateral swivel. Among the others in the portfolio, the Multi model has been designed for yachts with space issues to accommodate the gangway, while the Maxxy model has been designed for large yachts, with a load capacity up to 250 kg and can reach a length of 9 meters with a width of 1.2 meters.

Sanguineti Gangway App



The first smartphone application that allows you to operate the gangway with your phone. Once the system has been installed on board, the app can be downloaded free of charge, providing a safe alternative to traditional gangway remote controls. Applicable to gangways of all brands and models.



Ladders - *Boarding*



The king ladders designed by Sanguineti are studied and designed to guarantee the maximum comfort for on-board access to a wide range of vessels, satisfying customer requirements both in terms of functionality, design and in terms of use of the space on board. There are three different boarding ladder types in the portfolio: hydraulic, electric and manual. Several are the extras available, there is the possibility of inserting self-opening and self-levelling stanchions on the ladder, according to the position of the ladder. On the other hand, boarding ladders have been designed to be extremely safe and match every kind of

boat's needs. An example? There are three models with hydraulic command: fixed, revolving and caisson structure. Moreover, different versions of electric boarding ladders are available, operated by a built-in steel wire to improve the on-board fitting. All the models are made of a caisson in light alloy and stainless-steel structure. In addition, several manual boarding ladders complete this production line, ideal for small vessels or sailing boats. The handling is operated by wire or hoist with fixed steps. Lower platform retractable, made of light anodized alloy, walking surface in natural grated teak. Fixing on board with a stainless-steel plate.

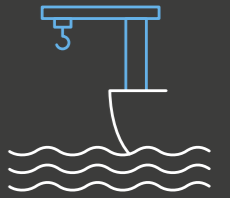
Ladders - *Bathing, Docking and Multifunctional*



Diving into the water or getting on and off the boat with Sanguineti's bathing and boarding ladders becomes safe and comfortable. The company's studies and research have been essential to create a product that respects both the technical and aesthetic aspects. The most important feature is that ladders

are perfectly integrated with the hull when not in use.

Regarding bathing ladders, different models are available to meet various needs, from the simplest manual and fixed, made in light alloy, up to a more articulated and hydraulic version, fully retractable into structure inside the boat after use.



Handlings

Different handling solutions are developed and produced for any type of vessels.

Creating and designing bespoke handling systems means giving the boat new and additional possibilities of use, exploiting areas on board that sometimes might not be fully used and appreciated.

Handlings line includes: telescopic navigation light masts, hatch doors, aft doors, lockings, platforms, balcony handling systems and automatic handrails, hard top handling systems, boarding and access aid system from/at sea for people with disabilities.

The production line also includes tender handlings with a wide range of solutions according to the specific needs and space availability. Cranes models are studied and designed to guarantee the maximum security on board, they can be hydraulically or electrically operated.

All cranes combine solidity, attention to details and high standard quality, delivering a turnkey product which allows an easy assembling on board.

Among handlings lines: travelling lift, fly bridge, garage cranes, jib cranes, rescue SOLAS, LSA Solas under 500gt.



Deck equipment

For almost seventy years, the production of deck accessories has distinguished the company in the nautical world. All over the range, the well-known retractable winch was the world-first designed by Sanguineti in the early 1990s. The winch mechanism, either fixed or with motorized up and down movement, eliminates encumbrance on deck, mainly used for mooring. The diameter of the drum and other characteristics will differ according to the size of the vessel. Designed to support different loads and speeds, electrically or hydraulically driven, the winch is also available in black anodization.



Anchors

The deck accessories range is completed with the series of Sanguineti SC92 anchors and pool anchors, in addition to all the accessories aimed at achieving the maximum functionality on deck for boats of all sizes. Among these are included chain stops, stainless steel swivel joints and, for a complete supply and adaptability to the winches in the portfolio, different types of galvanized or stainless-steel chain.





