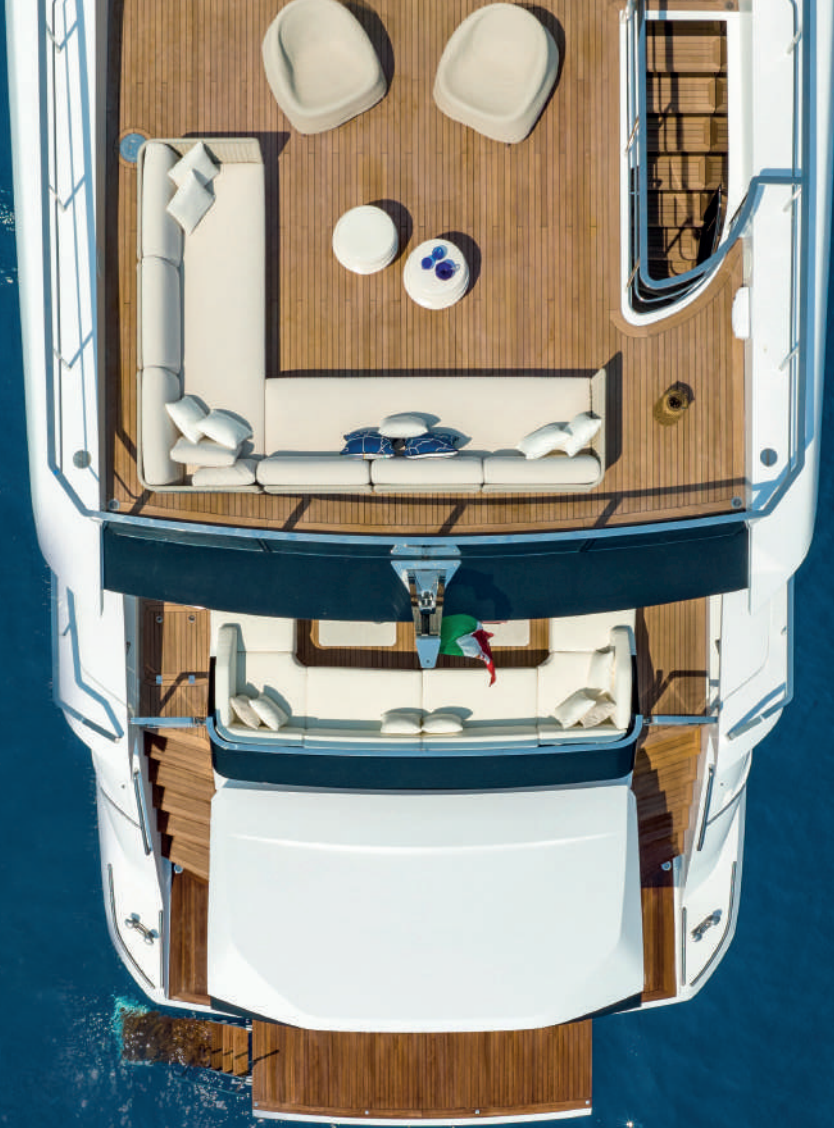
Quick Group, international leader in the design, production, and sale of nautical equipment and complex integrated systems for yachts and superyachts, operates in more than 110 countries worldwide.
